#### Feb 2nd 10:15 AM Losing Religion and Finding Jesus Act 8:1-3; 9:1-19

Christ calls us to know him and be with him. When we move from studying God to knowing God, there is a relationship that awaits us. A relationship with a person-Jesus Christ. Saul was into religion. But his universe was shaken by a person-Jesus Christ. And when Christ shook his universe, of course—He turned his world upside down. Let's talk about Paul and His good friend, Jesus.

#### Feb 9th 10:15 AM I Want to Walk Like Jesus Acts 9:26-31

Following Jesus is not hard. He said his burden was light and his yoke was easy. But religion, even Christian religion can be a heavy burden to bear. That's why Jesus wants us free from it. Even people who walked with Jesus found ways to avoid walking with Paul—because he was different, they were afraid of him, and plainly they couldn't believe that God could change a Saul into a Paul. But He can and He does—and He can change you and me too. Walking like Jesus—a bumpy road or smooth sailing, He want to grow us.

### Feb 16th 10:15 AM I Want to Live Like Jesus Philippians 1:9b-30

Living like Jesus means committing to a life that looks like Him because He is the perfect example of what Christ wants for us. It isn't a class, it's a way of living.
